My Dear Parish Family:

Our parish Renew & Rebuild campaign is complete. We, as a parish community, did very well. Thank you to all who supported the campaign. 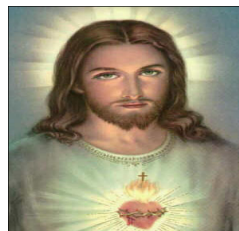
