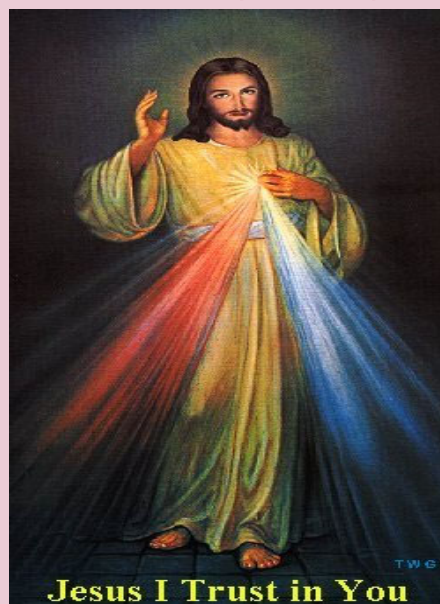

My Dear Parish Family:

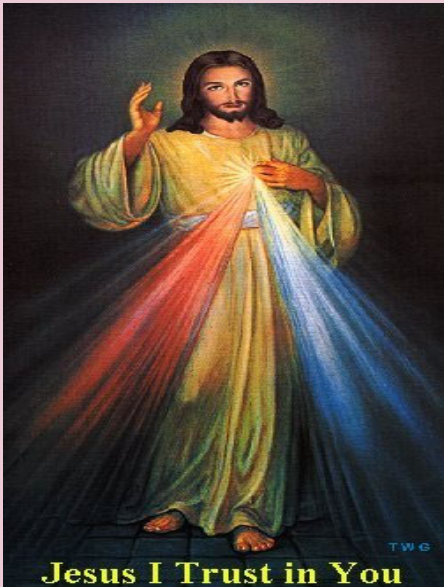

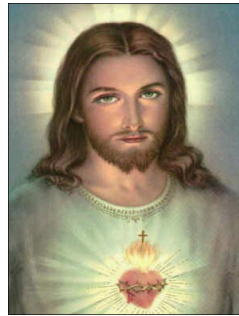

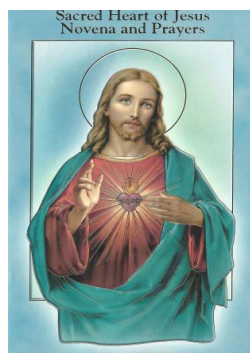
CLOTHING DRIVE NEXT WEEKEND - MAY 4th/5th
