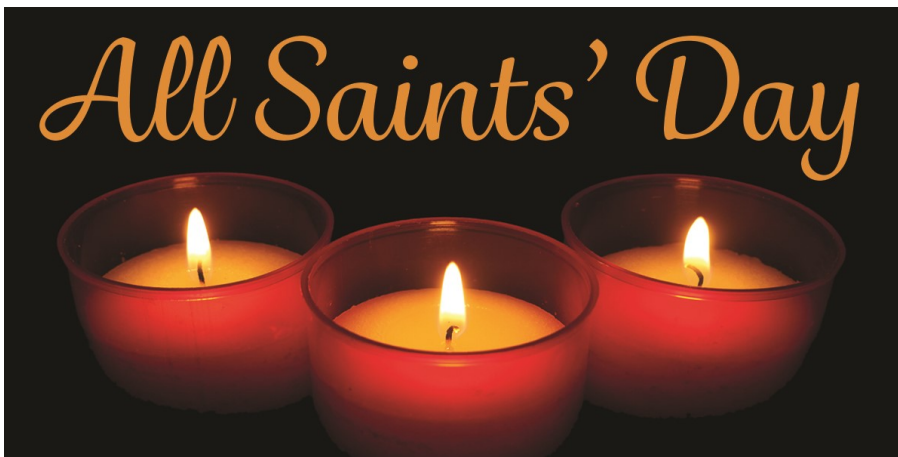

All Souls' Day – Plenary Indulgence

A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in purgatory, is granted each and every day from Nov 1 to Nov 8, who devoutly visit a cemetery and there pray, if only mentally, for the departed.

Requirements for obtaining a plenary indulgence:

- Do the work while in a state of grace,
- Receive Sacramental confession within 20 days of the work (several plenary indulgences may be earned per reception),
- Receive Eucharistic communion (one plenary indulgence may be earned per reception),
- Pray for the pope's intentions (Our Father and Hail Mary, or other appropriate prayer, is sufficient),
- Have no attachment to sin (even venial) – i.e., it is sufficient that the Christian makes an act of the will to love God and despise sin.

Requirements for a partial indulgence: The work must be done while in a state of grace and with the general intention of earning an indulgence.

STEWARDSHIP TIMELINE

Dear Saint James Parish family,

In the coming weeks, we are going to be renewing our stewardship way of life as a parish family. Many of Jesus' parables in the gospels focus on stewardship, to the point it becomes clear: discipleship and stewardship are synonymous. It is not easy to make commitments. But a meaningful life is one committed to love. There is no love where there is no giving. The happiest people on earth, not only statistically, but in my own personal life—the happiest people I know are always the most giving. Each of us is given only so much time, talent and treasure. What matters is "how" we give and not "what" we give. The how of giving brings to mind one of the most vividly described scenes in the gospel. Jesus is people watching and he observes people putting offerings in the treasury. Then he speaks about the way one should give, a way that is not focused on quantity, but quality. He would spend his life for me, Christ says, that is is the Christian life. It is not just something we do in Wichita, or about Catholic schools, stewardship is discipleship. Join me, my brothers and sisters, in renewing our offering to God, that we might become missionary disciples, fully alive in the Lord! In the end, Jesus reminds, we must be rich in what matters to God. Let us keep each other in prayer as we discern how we give. Please know you are in my daily thoughts and prayers, and that each day, I lift up before God, each of you, your joys, your sorrows, your accomplishments, and your hurts. May God bless Saint James now and always!
