ADDITIONAL WORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES FOR LENT

- **A Holy Hour of Eucharistic Adoration** takes place every Friday morning in Lent from 6:00 am until the start of 7:00 am Mass.

- **The Holy Rosary** will be prayed **after Saturday evening Mass and before Sunday morning Mass.**

LENTEN CHARITY COLLECTION

During Lent, the Ladies' Auxiliary is collecting household items for the Catholic Refugee Resettlement Project. The following items, either new or used in good condition, will be given to refugee families in our community: flatware (forks, spoons, knives, serving pieces); small appliances (in working order), such as coffee pots, toasters, toaster ovens, mixers, etc.; puzzles (if no pieces are missing); kitchen storage containers (Glad, tupperware, etc). **Collection boxes are at both doors.**
