Established on November 4, 1934, our St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church is 84 years young this Sunday! Our patron saint was a cardinal of Milan and a leading figure of the Catholic Reformation. November 1610, Paul V solemnly canonized Charles Borromeo, and fixed his feast for the 4th day of November. He is credited with founding the seminaries for the education of priests. He was also a patron of the arts and education. Although he attained a position of great power, he used it with humility, personal sanctity and selflessness to reform the church.
