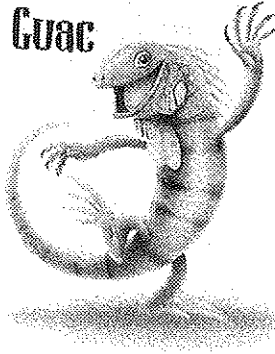

Baptism: Children should be baptized within the first few months after birth. Baptism should take place in one's proper parish. Registered parishioners should contact Fr. Richard at the Office for information regarding the selection of Godparents, any required preparations and the date & time of Baptism.

Reconciliation: Confessions are normally heard on Saturday, before the 4:00 PM evening Mass. Other opportunities are possible by appointment.

Eucharistic Adoration: Spend a refreshing hour before the Lord in prayer... in our daily chapel, from conclusion of morning Mass until 3:00 pm on Thursdays.

Marriages: Either the bride or the groom must be a registered parishioner of St. Joseph/ St. Ann Parish. At least six months of preparation time is required in our Diocese. Weddings are never booked by phone or by third-parties; a **personal interview is required**. Call the office for an appointment.

Funerals: Contact the office to make necessary arrangements for funeral liturgy.

New Parishioners: Welcome! To register, fill out one of the blue forms, they are located in the office, and return it to the church office or drop it in the collection basket. Change your address or Phone number?, we need to get that updated in the computer too.

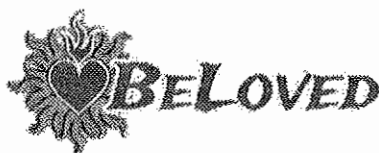
