**Baptism:** Children should be baptized within the first few months after birth. Baptism should take place in one’s proper parish. Registered parishioners should contact **Fr. Richard** at the Office for information regarding the selection of Godparents, any required preparations and the date and time of Baptism.

**Reconciliation:** Confessions are normally heard on Saturdays before the mass from 3:15–3:40 PM. Other opportunities are possible by appointment by calling Father Richards’s cell at 318-282-9477

**Eucharistic Adoration:** Spend a refreshing hour before the Lord in prayer in our daily chapel, from the conclusion of morning Mass until 3:00 PM on Thursdays.

**Marriages:** Either the bride or the groom must be a registered parishioner of St. Joseph/ St. Ann Parish. At least six months of preparation time is required in our Diocese. Weddings are never booked by phone or by third-parties; a **personal interview is required**. Call the office for an appointment.

**Funerals:** Contact the office to make necessary arrangements for the funeral liturgy.

To register, fill out one of the blue forms located at the church office or in the church foyer and return it to the church office or drop it in the weekly collection basket.
