Religion: We will be practicing for our presentation at Mass on Thursday and preparing our information on our 4 saints. We then take our book back and tackle Chapter 4.

Math: In math this week we will concentrate on problem solving strategies and we will begin preparing for our next test on Friday. I will continue to quiz them on

their addition facts at 4.5 minutes. On Halloween we will have a special lesson-Trick or Treat on Goblin Street.

Science: This week we will look at angiosperms. We will describe their structure, function, seed development and their life cycle. Ask your kids what an angiosperm is, if you don't know. I hope to have a special science lesson on Halloween.

Reading: Now that we have been introduced to all of our characters and how they got to the Times Square Subway Station. Mr. Smedley will discover something amazing about Chester, what is it? We will learn more about Crickets from Sai Fong in Chapter 6.
