

### From our Nurse:

#### Guidelines for parents to keep their children home from school:

1. Vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain
2. Temperature greater than 101 degrees within 24 hours of the start of the school day
3. Uncontrollable coughing, sore throat, heavy nasal congestion
4. A communicable illness (i.e. strep throat, the flu, head lice, pink eye)

If a communicable situation is suspected, please inform the school nurse so that she can monitor other students, and if necessary, notify other parents. Your child should not return to school until the symptoms have ceased for at least 24 hours, or he/she is on prescribed medication for a full 24 hours. If a child comes to school sick, he/she will be sent home.
