THIS WEEK'S REFLECTIONS

Almighty and merciful God, by whose gift your faithful offer You right and praiseworthy service, grant, we pray, that we may hasten without stumbling to receive the things You have promised. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. Amen.

Today's Mass Readings

1st reading: Deuteronomy 6:2-6
2nd reading: Hebrews 7:23-28
Gospel: Mark 12:28b-34

Given that the main theme of today's Mass is to love God and to love one's neighbor, it is a good opportunity to remind ourselves that love is not an emotion--it is a choice. We do not always receive consolation for making that choice, but we find peace when we truly love with our heart, soul, and strength.

Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 18:2-4, 47, 51

This is a hymn of praise to God who delivered us from all our enemies. We hear that God is a rock, fortress, and deliverer (titles that give a sense of how safe we feel in His presence).

The First Reading and the Gospel speak of how we should love God with all our heart, soul, and strength. This love is an act of trust.

It is not easy to make this act of trust, especially when we have been hurt by so many things throughout our lives. But this psalm reminds us that God's love is the only love in our lives that will never go away and never make mistakes.
