The Magician's Nephew by C. S. Lewis

Book and assignment must be completed by September 4th.

Assignment:

C.S. Lewis used the genre of fantasy to create a world in which characters must regularly confront issues of good and evil, right and wrong. Write your own fantasy about a kingdom. Create a world based wholly on your imagination, filled with fanciful creatures facing conflicts that test their strength, courage and morality.

Decide how you would run your kingdom. Decide on the name of your kingdom, what laws you would put into effect, and how you would divide responsibilities among you. What would you like to be called: just, valiant or magnificent?

Your essay must be at least 3 paragraphs.
