

“My kingdom does not belong to this world.”

The response of Jesus to Pilate, the most powerful human authority in Palestine at that time, raises a very important question for those of us who call ourselves Christians and claim to be followers and imitators of Jesus Christ: *Where is our kingdom?* Is it our home? Is it our family? Is it our job or profession? Is it our material wealth or financial security? Is it our hobby or a certain sport? Is it a combination of some or all of these? All of these are good. And to the extent that we have them, God wants us to use and enjoy them for ourselves *and for others*, to the best of our ability. That is how we imitate Jesus. If and when one or more of those things becomes *our kingdom* to which we devote an inordinate portion of our time, energy and resources, we become so attached to *our kingdom in this world* that we risk of losing our right to join Jesus in *His kingdom that is not of this world*.

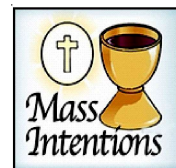
