

“Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nail marks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe.”

When Thomas was told that Jesus had risen from the dead and appeared to the other disciples while he was not with them, he has difficulty believing that it could be possible. Thomas did not lack faith in Jesus. But the implications of Jesus rising from the dead were so immense that Thomas wanted to be certain. When Jesus learned that Lazarus had died, the other disciples tried to dissuade Jesus from going near Jerusalem to get to Bethany because the Jewish leaders were seeking to kill him, it was Thomas who said, “Let’s go die with him!” When Thomas sees the Risen Jesus and is invited to put his finger and hands into the wounds, he tells Thomas, “Do not be unbelieving, but believe.” It is Thomas who proclaims, “My Lord and my GOD.” Jesus then speaks to us: “Blessed are those who have not seen, and have believed.” In the midst of the challenges and difficulties of our life, do we sometimes have doubts. That is normal. But we can have faith that Jesus is telling us, “Do not be unbelieving, but believe.”

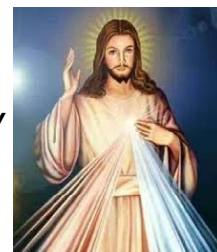
