PART I

Required Text: *Oliver Twist*, by Charles Dickens

Directions:

Read *Oliver Twist* and keep a journal/notebook while you are reading. You should be writing down "new vocabulary" (write down and look up words that you do not know or have never heard before), notes on characters, plot and your thoughts while reading the novel.

Assessment:

The notebook will be handed in for a test grade. Your grade will depend on how the aforementioned points are addressed in your journal. **YOU CAN DRAW PICTURES TOO!** The pictures should represent scenes/actions in the novel. THERE WILL BE A TEST ON THE NOVEL WHEN YOU COME BACK TO SCHOOL IN SEPTEMBER.

PART II

Required Text: CHOOSE ANY BOOK YOU WOULD LIKE TO READ!

Directions: Select a book from any subject/topic you are interested in. Do you have a hobby, sport, topic that fascinates you? TELL US ABOUT IT! Choose a book that is high school grade level, at least 100 pages, and create a project that you will present to the class. You can make a diorama, a poster board/tri-fold, build something out of clay, paint a picture, wear costume to represent your book, HAVE FUN AND BE CREATIVE!

Assessment:

You must bring the book and your project to class on the first day and be prepared to present your book and project to the class.
