

Columbia University Rare Book & Manuscript Library (directions)

The Exhibit and Talk on Unique Wagner Materials in the Columbia University Rare Book & Manuscript Library (RBML) is in Butler Library, which is at the South end of the main Columbia University quadrangle, positioned between 114th Street and what would be 115th Street, and between Broadway and Amsterdam Avenues. The mailing address is useful for those taking a taxi or car service: 535 West 114th Street. This entrance is not a public entrance, so please walk around to the front of the building, that being on the North side of the building, on a level with 115th that is now pedestrian only.

Public transportation:

Subway: #1 train (local train) to Broadway & 116th St.

Bus: M104 which goes up Broadway and makes a stop on Broadway between 113th and 114th St., and then at 116th Street.

For those who cannot negotiate stairs, please use the campus entrance at 115th and Broadway and walk East to the front of Butler Library. There are no steps on this route. The online directions to Butler Library are here: <https://library.columbia.edu/locations/butler/directions.html>

When you arrive at Butler, go into the Library Information Office that is just inside the front door and to the left. They will have the list of Wagner group attendees. They will either send you up to RBML on the 6th floor through a side door, or they will give you a pass to go through the guard's desk.

To get to RBML, turn left and take the East elevators to the 6th Floor. Then turn right and proceed through the double glass doors. We will meet in the Chang Seminar Room that is directly around to the right of the double glass doors through the Chang Octagon Exhibition Room. There is a coat rack in the Chang Room. Please do not bring food or drink, water excepted.
