PASTOR'S MESSAGE: Easter Sunday

"They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him." (John 20:2)

"Hallelujah, the Lord is risen. He is risen indeed!" The catchphrase for every Emmaus retreatant. The Emmaus movement has been enlivening parishes around the diocese of Orlando. Its emphasis on Jesus' risen presence accompanying two disciples on the road to Emmaus has renewed and invigorated the faith of many.

The whole Paschal Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday is a short spiritual 'retreat' for the parish. We renew our baptismal promises Sunday during the Easter season, replacing the Creed or Profession of Faith. We also hear the return of the bells rung at consecration time to signify the inner joy in our hearts.
