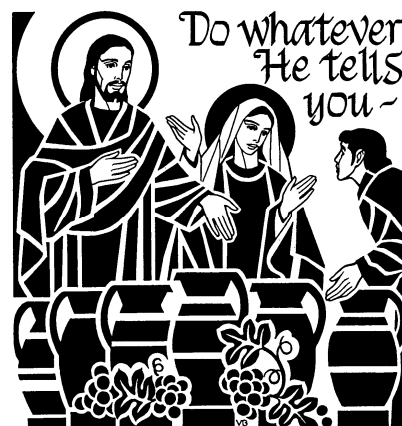

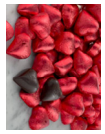

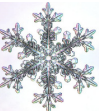

Will Mass ever be canceled due to severe weather? In most instances, Father can say Mass in Weston no matter the weather. If the weather becomes too dangerous for Father to travel to Platte City, our plan is to communicate that via an email to parishioners, to post it on our websites, to put a message on our voicemail, &/or to notify the TV stations. Generally, **"no news" means things are going as scheduled**. Since the Sunday obligation is important, priests hesitate to cancel Mass. Barring dangerous conditions, Father will try to make it for Mass but wants parishioners to always be prudent of their own situations & do what is best for them.

**What you need to know about charitable IRA giving:** Contributions from traditional IRAs. **You must be 70 1/2 or older** when the distribution is made. Distributions must be made directly from your IRA to charity.

**Individuals who take required minimum withdrawals & want to avoid paying tax on the distribution.** Give your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) directly to a qualified charity without having to report it as taxable income. Contact your IRA administrator to learn your RMD. **Taxpayers who don't itemize their deductions.** An IRA charitable transfer most benefits the nearly 2/3rds of Americans who do not itemize deductions & therefore do not receive a tax benefit for giving to charity.

**Itemizing taxpayers who've reached the charitable giving limit.** Donors who itemize their taxes are prohibited from deducting more than 50 percent of their adjusted gross income as charitable donations. Donations from an IRA are excluded from this percentage limit, allowing individuals who have reached the 50 percent threshold to give more.
