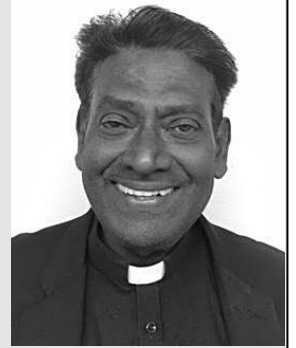

Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time • June 12, 2016

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Greetings of peace and love from Fr. Joe Arokiam. Fr. Steve Brice asked me to share in this bulletin of my experience and impression about the people in the United States. Yes, indeed, I said that I could share in this bulletin some of my thoughts and reflections about how United States of America is with the rest of the world and especially with India in its relationship in times of needs. I could say the relationship of the Americans is one of compassion and service towards the suffering humanity.



Before going to this topic, I would like to kid you with the following joke. A couple namely Mr. Donovan and Mrs. Donovan were married to each other and their marriage was solemnized by a pastor known as O'Reilly. One day Fr. O'Reilly, the pastor of the parish, asked how they were doing and Mrs. Donovan said fine, but a very sad part of their life was that they had no children. Fr. O'Reilly said he was on his way to Rome and would light the candles for them so that God would bless them with children. Several years later Fr. O'Reilly happened to meet Mrs. Donovan and asked how things were going on and asked if they had any children yet. She said yes. God blessed them with ten children including three sets of twins. Fr. O'Reilly said praise the Lord and asked how is your husband Mr. Donovan doing and asked where is he now? She said he just left for Rome to blow out the candles lit by you!! Yes, the children are God given gifts to their parents whom God gives them out of compassion and generosity.

I am dealing with in this bulletin about the compassion and concern of United States of America with India. According to me, Americans are very generous and kind in helping the third world people in their sufferings. As I was a small boy studying in the school, I noticed that when India faced the drought, it was America that came forward to help with wheat, wheat flour and oil and clothes for the suffering humanity irrespective of caste, creed and religion. Many of the Hindus, the non-Christians, came to Christianity because of the help rendered by the United States. Many of the Hindus who embraced the Christianity were called as wheat or oil Christians. Hence we appreciate the generosity of the Americans for the help to the afflicted world.

Secondly, the United States never wants or never encourages slavery in any of the countries in the world. For example, when the South Africa was under the slavery of the whites, the Blacks didn't have any rights or freedom of speech. A Freedom Fighter namely Nelson Mandela, a black leader fought against the South African whites against slavery. He was tortured and imprisoned for about 25 years. At this time of the crisis, it was America which came forward to support the blacks and forced the whites to give freedom to the people and it was America that worked a lot to put an end to slavery and Nelson Mandela was relieved by the interference or intervention of America. It was by the intervention of the United States the South Africans got independence and Mr. Nelson Mandela was elected as the first President of South Africa. Now the South African people are enjoying the freedom and they have their own government. Hence the credit goes to the United States of America. From this it is clear how the United States intended to establish peace and tranquility and equality with the countries. I do appreciate the attitude of Americans and I have a very high appreciation and respect for the same. Hence, if any country suppressed the freedom of the other countries, it will be the United States to be the first one to say Stop It.

Lastly I wish to share with you my experience in Loyal, Greenwood and Willard. As I arrived here on March 1, 2016, I was warmly received by Fr. Steve Brice, our pastor. Now I completed 3 full months since March 1st. One more month I will stay. I find people in these 3 parishes are so good and kind and helpful to do my pastoral ministry over here. As I did not have a drivers license, some good people like Pete and Joan Lindner and Jack Barrett were so kind enough to drive me in their vehicles to offer the Holy Mass in the parishes. Special thanks to Jack Barrett and Chris Lindner who have very much helped me to learn driving skills. I owe special thanks to Fr. Steve Brice for his kindness and hospitality and encouragement in my pastoral ministry. May the Lord bless him and bless you. I owe also, thanks to Margie, our secretary and Grace, our Financial secretary and Chuck for the help towards my growth. I do continue to pray for you all. I am leaving on June 30th for my future ministry to Viroqua to be a pastor of two parishes. Kindly pray for me for the success of my ministry.

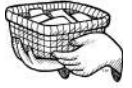

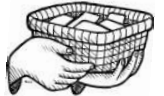
