Pastor Update

Father Jazmines was ordained Dec. 8, 1979 in Toronto, Canada. Father Jazmines became business administrator at Wadhams Hall Seminary in 1991 and was incardinated into the Diocese of Ogdensburg on May 1, 1992.

Father Jazmines served as administrator at St. Patrick's in Hogansburg, St. Patrick's in Brasher Falls, St. George in Burke, St. Augustine's in Peru and then as parochial vicar at St. Paul's in Black River. He then served as administrator in Malone, Owls Head and Titusville before assuming that role at St. James in Gouverneur. He became pastor of that church in 1996, also serving as chaplain at Gouverneur Correctional Facility.

In 1999, Father Vincente was named administrator of St. Augustine's in Peru, becoming pastor of that church in 2000.

He served as pastor at St. Michael's Church in Standish and St. Bernard's in Lyon Mountain in 2005.
