

Third Sunday of Easter May 5, 2019

This week's Gospel reading from John enjoys a number of themes not Jesus said Do you love Me? least of which has to do with hearing Christ's call to live differently but returning to our "comfort zones." Even after seeing the risen Lord & receiving his blessing & missionary charge, his disciples go back to what they were doing before Jesus called them. How often do we retreat from the Lord's call so that we may remain with what is comfortable & familiar?
