

PRESCHOOL TEACHER

The Preschool teacher must have a love of children. The teacher must display Christian principles in the community as well as the classroom and have a clear understanding of basic Christian teachings.

The teacher must have a college degree in Early Childhood or Elementary Education or in a related field. The teacher must also be eligible to receive a State Police clearance.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Daily planning and preparation of classroom curriculum activities which may include work at home**
- 2. Be available at least 1/2 hour before and class**
- 3. Hold parent-teacher conferences twice a year (winter and spring)**
- 4. Send home monthly newsletters concerning areas covered in class**
- 5. Organize classroom parties for holidays and special occasions**
- 6. Plan and direct the children in two school programs (Christmas and end-of-the year)**
- 7. Leave classroom presentable at the end of the day.**
