- 1. All Day Confessions This coming Wednesday, the priests of the Diocese of London, will be offering the Sacrament of Reconciliation in our Churches. Here, at St. Mary's, I will be available from 9:00 AM to 12 Noon, from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM and again at 7:00 PM until finished. If you plan on receiving the Sacrament this Lent, I would encourage you to take advantage of this opportunity.
- 2. Due to the All day Confessions, Mass next Wednesday will be at 8:00 AM.
- 3. Holy Week

Palm Sunday is next weekend. All Palm Sunday Masses will begin outside (weather permitting) with the Blessing of Palms and the first Gospel. Afterwards, we will process into the Church to commemorate the entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem. On Monday, the priests of the diocese will be spending the afternoon in prayer with our Bishop. At 7:00 PM we will be gathering at St. Peter's Cathedral for the Mass of Chrism. All are most welcome!

It is on Thursday evening at 7:00 PM that we will celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper. In this celebration we mark the institution of the Eucharist and of the Priestly Order and the commandment of the Lord concerning fraternal charity. This will be followed by quiet prayer in the presence of our Lord until Midnight.



ST. VINCENT DE PAUL MONTHLY REPORT -- MARCH 2019

On March 16, some members of our Society attended a regional Meet and Greet in Simcoe. Spending time with our sisters and brothers in the society from Simcoe, Delhi and Port Dover, we learned about their commitment to community dinners, to the elderly in nursing homes, and to the hungry. Our mission is to "see Christ in anyone who suffers, come together as a family, have personal contact with the poor, and help in all possible ways." (ssvp.on.ca) This mission is a holy mission, and by the Grace of the Holy Spirit, we honour it here at St. Mary's. Throughout March, our SSVP emergency phone line assisted thirteen single adults and nine families with food; six single adults and four families with rent; two families with hydro; two single adults with car fuel; one single senior with insurance; and one single senior with Internet costs. At our Friendship Dinners, the numbers have been fluctuating with the weather. We served 60 guests on March 6; 68 on March 13; 82 on March 20; 60 on March 27. There are 360 SSVP Conferences across Ontario working to live up to the words under our logo: "serviens in spe" which means "to serve in hope, the hope that comes from our Lord Jesus Christ."
