Dear Bishop Zurek:

On behalf of the Subcommittee on the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD), thank you for your support of the collection in 2016. Your diocese's generous contribution of \$15,921.90 has empowered people on the margins across the United States to work to break the cycle of poverty.

This year the national date for the CCHD collection is November 18-19, which is also the first celebration of the World Day of the Poor. In his statement establishing the World Day of the Poor, Pope Francis called for Christian communities to mark the occasion with "moments of encounter and friendship, solidarity and concrete assistance" with people living in poverty.

Poverty challenges us but it also presents for us an opportunity for true encounter with the suffering flesh of Christ. The support of your diocese for the CCHD collection is a concrete sign of the Church's solidarity with people living in poverty and its commitment to bring hope and joy to those in need. Your contributions will support low-income led groups as they work to break the cycle of poverty across the United States. Additionally, twenty-five percent of funds collected will remain in your diocese to fund local anti-poverty efforts.
