- Grades 9 and 10 will begin August 14, 2019 at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton in Odessa
- The school day will run from 8:00 a.m. to 4:36 p.m.
- Each day will begin with Chapel, including prayer, announcements, etc.
- Focus on STREAM: Science, Technology, Religion (Theology), Engineering, Arts, Mathematics
- The maximum student-teacher ratio will be 22:1
- 300–350 maximum capacity to maintain student-teacher ratio (3A high school)
- Students will participate in sacramental/liturgical life of the Catholic Church, including weekly Mass, regular confession, devotional opportunities, observance of certain Holy Days, and more
- Dual Credit relationship with Odessa College
 - 100% of Holy Cross students will graduate with an Associates Degree
 - Savings on college tuition and fees of \$5,500 to \$8,500
- HCCHS is applying to Texas Catholic Conference of Bishops Education Department (TCCBED) for accreditation. There are several TCCBED requirements and the school administration is in the process of meeting each of them.
- School uniforms will be available through Mills Uniform Co. in the Spring of 2019
- Sports teams will include 6-man football, cross country, basketball, and volleyball
- Foreign languages will be part of each student’s required studies
- Basic Theology classes will be part of the core curriculum

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
