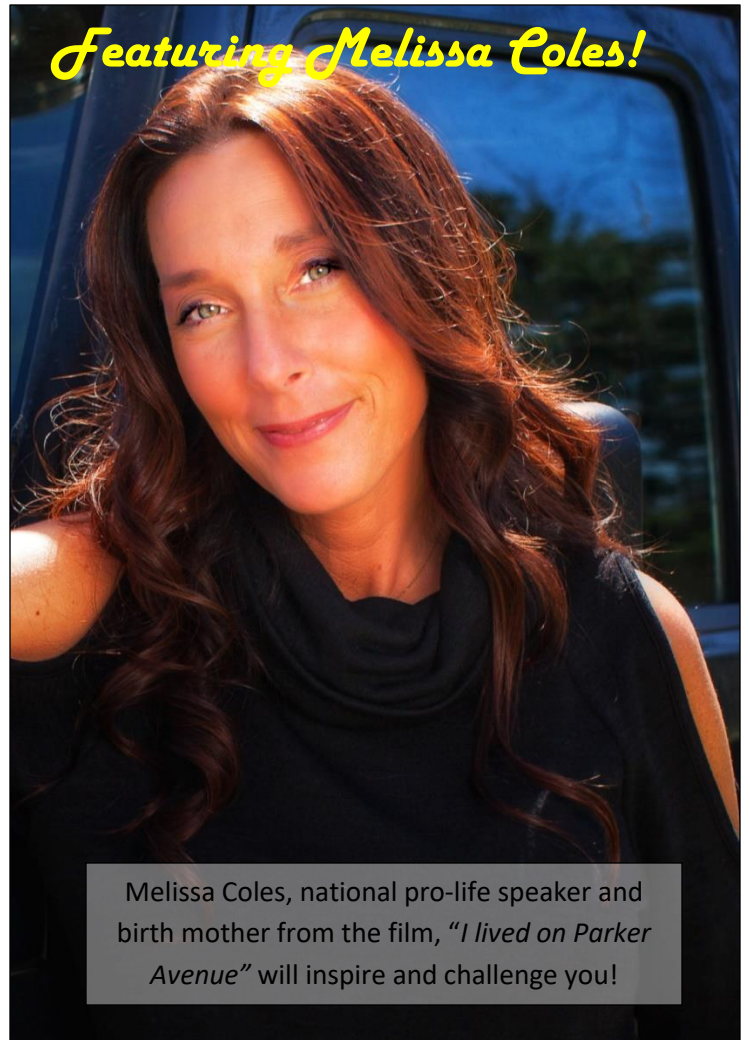
Doors open @ 6:30pm for Pro-life resource Fair, 30 minute documentary at 7:30 followed by Melissa's testimony.
