Sept. 16	Green	Ch. 1: God's Plan for Creation	Divine Revelation is the way God makes himself and his plans for creation known. We can participate in that plan by caring for creation.	Matthew 21:28-32 (parable of the two sons) Why is it important to follow through on your promises to others?
Sept. 23	Green	Ch. 2: Made to Be With God	True happiness is only found in communion with God. Religion expresses our relationship with him.	Matthew 21:33-43 (parable of the tenants) What can you do in your week to help the love of God grow in the world?
Sept. 30	Green	Ch. 3: Signs of God's Presence and Unit Review	One way God communicates his love is through signs.
