



### **School Dress Code**

Uniform order forms are available at the Aquin office or on the school website [www.aquin.org](http://www.aquin.org) if you need to order shirts or sweatshirts.

Boy's Proper attire for boys at Aquin Catholic Elementary School:

- Tan or navy dress pants or shorts (Shorts may be worn August-October and April-June).
- Aquin white, black or navy polo must be worn at all times.
- Aquin navy, black or white sweatshirt may be worn over Aquin polos.
- Socks must be worn at all times. Closed-toe and closed heel shoes are to be worn at all times.
- Sandals and crocs are NOT allowed to be worn at school.**

Girls: Proper attire for boys at Aquin Elementary Catholic School:

- Tan or navy dress pants, shorts or skirts. (Shorts may be worn August-October and April-June).
- Shorts must be walking shorts length.**
- Aquin navy, black or white sweatshirts may be worn over Aquin polos.
- Socks must be worn at all times. Tights in navy or white are allowed. Closed-toe and closed-heel shoes are to be worn at all times.
- Jewelry and hair accessories must not take away from the educational program or students will be asked to remove them.
- Sandals and crocs are NOT allowed to be worn at school.**

### **Aquin Dress Code Additions (Approved September 30, 2015)**

#### **Out of Uniform Days**

- All applicable dress code rules apply.
- Shorts should be of a socially acceptable and appropriate length and must be at or below mid-thigh.
- For the safety of all, socks and closed-toe and closed-heel shoes are to be worn even on out-of-uniform days.

#### **Extracurricular and Co-curricular Dress Code**

- All applicable dress code rules apply.
- Students may be out of uniform on game days or performance days.
- The coach or sponsor will determine dress code for specific sports or activities.

**Undergarments, Underwear and bras:**

- Underwear is not to be markedly visible through the polo or shirt that is being worn.

**Undershirts**

- Only solid-colored white t-shirts (no visible lettering or graphics) may be worn under uniform shirts.

**Ultimately**

- We are a Catholic school and require a level of decorum that is consistent with our mission.
- When in doubt about a uniform item, don't wear it. Seek clarification first.
- The principal has the final word on dress code attire.
