Lay Director Election... We are beginning the process of electing our next Lay Director to the Board of Directors for our parish to replace one that has completed his term. The Directors must attend the annual meeting of the Board and any additional meetings that may be called as needed.

The Lay Director him/herself must be at least 25 years old and must 1) be in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church, and 2a) either have domicile within the boundaries of the Parish, have received a tax receipt from the Parish in the previous year, or be registered for envelopes with the Parish prior to February 1st, 2019, or 2b) be the immediate family members living with someone who meets the requirement in 2a. Nominations must be accompanied by the person's name, contact information, and the signatures of 10 supporters over the age of 18. Only those signatures of support from people who themselves are in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church and who are also Registered Members of the Parish will count toward the nomination requirements. Please note that if any mistake exists in this announcement the nomination and election process will be governed by the Bylaws of St. Paul's Roman Catholic Parish (Summerside) Inc.

Nominations close February 13th, 2019 at 11:00am and will be received in the parish office. The election, if required, will take place at the weekend Masses of March 3rd, 2019.
