How does it work?

- Volunteers decorate their trunks, so kids can easily go safely from trunk to trunk for treats...TRUNK o' TREAT!

Car Volunteers

- Arrive at the St. Paul Church parking lot as close to **5:15 pm** as possible. You will need time to set up your decorations once you are parked.
- Provide some treats for the children. You will also be given an additional supply of treats from donations we receive.
- Decorate your trunk any way you'd like – **be creative!** For ideas, go online and search “trunk or treat”. Please not too scary for the little ones. You can dress up too!
- If you want to illuminate your trunk, please remember **NO candles/flames of any kind!**
- **No glass decorations of any kind!**
- Your car must remain parked until the end of the event (event runs 6-7 pm)
- If you wish to be parked next to someone, please arrive at the same time. We cannot save spaces.

Attendees

- All children are welcome and must be accompanied by an adult
- Arrive between 5:30 and 6 pm and park in the Parish Green lot. Alling St will be closed to traffic from the lot entrance up to Grove Hill.
- Dress in **appropriate Halloween costumes** – keep in mind this is a kid-friendly event!
- Please bring a bag to collect your treats (Note: there will be **allergy-safe** treats!)
- *Admission is a canned good and a donation of a bag of individually wrapped candy (1 each per child).*
