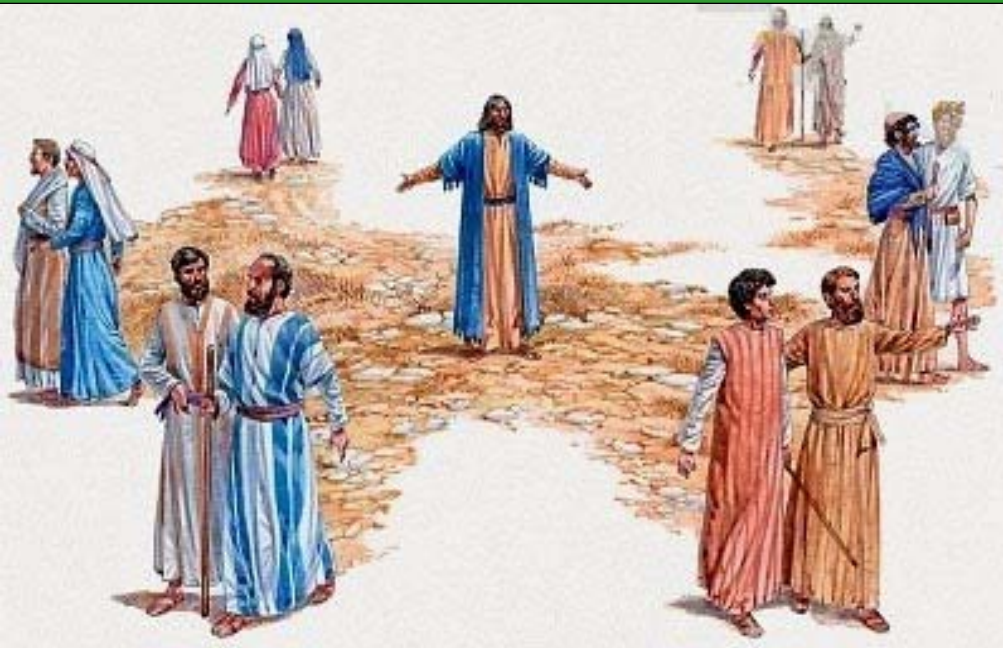

### 2019-2020 Faith Formation Registration

- July 20th** - Youth and Young Adult Ministry will be teaming up to offer the community of SS. Peter & Paul a day of service.



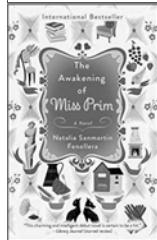

(Optional movie event precedes the retreat on Thursday Aug. 15th from 1:00-3:30 PM).

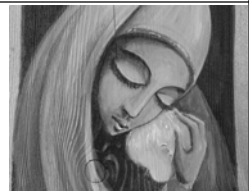

## BREAKING OPEN THE WORD

### *Introduction to This Weekend's Readings* *Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time*

*As modern day disciples Jesus sends us out, like the seventy-two, to proclaim the good news of God's kingdom. Let us pause for a moment to pray for strength humility and graces needed to fulfill this mission. . .*

#### **First Reading: Isaiah 66:10-14**

The last part of the book of Isaiah contains the words of a prophet who lived after the Jews returned from exile. In today's reading (which is a poem), the prophet sees a bright future for Jerusalem, and uses the image of God as a mother.

#### **Second Reading: Galatians 6:14-18**

In Galatia, a group of Christians attacked Paul's credentials as an apostle and accused him of false teaching because he said people can be saved without abiding by Jewish law. In this passage from the end of his letter to the Galatians, Paul defends his right to teach, and stresses that faith in the law has been replaced by faith in Jesus.

#### **Luke 10:1-12, 17-20**

During the ministry of Jesus there were many followers: crowds, disciples, apostles, and a special few. In the Gospel of Matthew, there are only twelve disciples, and they were also the twelve apostles (Matt 10:1-2). But Luke has a much more expansive view of discipleship. In fact, in Acts, he invents a feminine form of the word to mention Tabitha, a female disciple (9:36). And in today's gospel we have the mission of the seventy-two! Aside from this story in Luke we never hear about the seventy-two again.

And this simple lesson may give us hope today. According to Luke, men, women, the Twelve, the disciples, the seventy-two and many more were in a special relationship with Jesus, chosen to follow him and chosen also to be sent by him. In this gospel there were not such tight boundaries around who could or could not be a disciple. Instead, the situation seems to have been more fluid or dynamic. And that's likely a more accurate reflection of the situation around Jesus' earthly ministry. It would also seem to reflect our lives more accurately too, with dynamic, fluid relationships.

*Prayer: Lord Jesus, you called disciples during your time on earth and you continue to call disciples today. Give us an attentive spirit to hear your voice, so we may move from the margins to the inner circle, from the crowds seeking wonders to the disciples seeking wisdom. We ask this in your name. Amen.*
