Flocknote will be the primary form of communication between the Faith Formation program and YOU! Arrival & Dismissal

Preschool, Kindergarten, first, second and third graders must be delivered and picked up to/from their classroom by an **adult** and be signed in and out of their class. If you are using a carpool, make sure that the adult from your carpool is aware of this policy for your child(ren). Parents **are not** required to escort their fourth, fifth & sixth grade students to and from their classroom. For safety reasons, students who have not been picked up within 10 minutes after class has ended will be asked to wait in the Faith Formation Office. All students should use the restroom before class begins.
