**FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR**

Engagement, Evangelization, & Religious Education

Earlier this year, as I weave our RockKenRo parishes into a common mission, I have asked Jacob Williamson to lead an “Engagement” team including Dcn. Lee Miles and Steve Swank (religious education leadership), Erin Stuvek (evangelization), and Kristin Hayes (EDGE youth ministry).



On August 15, Dcn. Lee resigned as director of religious education at Holy Trinity Parish. He has served the catechists, parents, and children of Holy Trinity for over four years. He is a man of academic achievement and has held multiple ministerial positions in the Church. His affection for the education of children is clear. Many of you have known him to cherish, for example, the Vacation Bible Camp. Dcn. Lee’s catechists say, “He has been a mentor and a great friend. The children always come first and the students at St. Patrick’s are so lucky to have him”; “He made me feel like somebody; he always supported me”; “Deacon Lee was able to allow us to continue to teach and grow in Christ with our students through the years.” I thank Dcn. Lee for his work over these past four years and wish him the very best in his new position.

Despite Dcn. Lee’s sudden departure, our catechetical ministries must continue under safe and effective conditions. They immediately require on-site leadership. I have therefore appointed Steve Swank as pro tem coordinator of religious education for RockKenRo. He will also serve as a site manager at our Holy Trinity location and I am arranging for a site manager (who will report to Steve) at our St. Malachy location. Steve most recently has served the people of Saint Malachy as their coordinator of religious education.

**Dear RockKenRo community,**

The refrain in this Sunday’s Responsorial Psalm comes from the Gospel of Mark. It says, “Go out to all the world and tell the Good News.” For this month, I’ve been reflecting on the meaning of “Good News.” With so many changes going on around us in the diocese and so many scandals in the larger Church, frankly it can seem like what the Church has to offer people nowadays is bad news. The thought of evangelization can almost seem strange in a time like this. Shouldn’t we have our act together more, or wait until PR is looking better before we proclaim that people should come to the Catholic Church?

But here in the midst of all the current events, we all sing together at Mass, “Go out to all the world and tell the Good News.” The fact is that people will disappoint us, and the Church is full of human beings who, like us, are flawed – even deeply flawed. But our Good News isn’t about what people do. It’s about what Christ does with us sinful people. The Church still has Good News, now as much as ever. Christ is the Light of the World. He still scatters the darkness, heals our wounds, forgives our sins, and raises us up to new heights. He still loves us more than we can imagine, and He still wants to give us new life. That’s Good News, and it’s what the world needs to hear. Go out to all the world and tell the Good News!

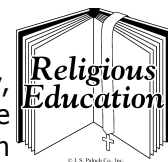
