PRESCRIPTION DRUG AND MEDICINE AUTHORIZATIONS

Prescription drugs and over-the-counter medicine should, wherever possible, be dispensed by a parent or guardian. If a child is given a prescription or medicine to "take 3 times daily", recommend to the parent that it be given to the child before he/she comes to school, after going home from school, and before bedtime.

Only when dispensing is required more often or with lunch should the school be involved in dispensing.

Any prescriptions or over-the-counter medicine must be in the original, labeled container and stored under lock and key.
