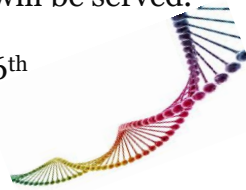

Financial Report 27 – 28 April 2019

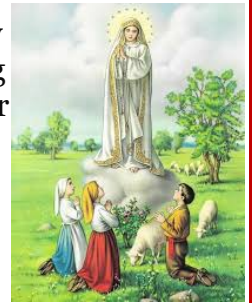
Attendance: 738 Offering: \$5,126.82

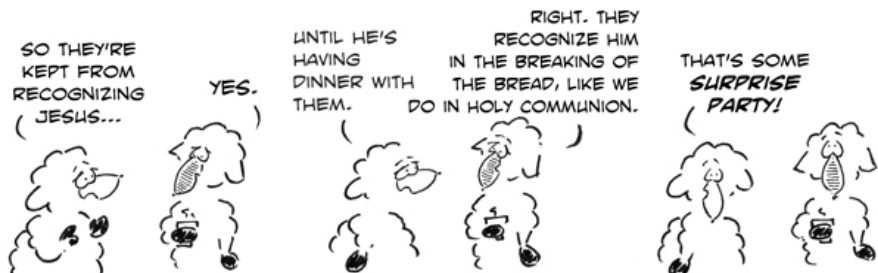

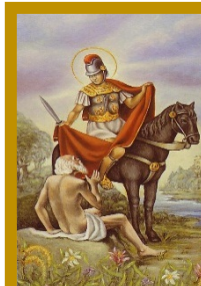

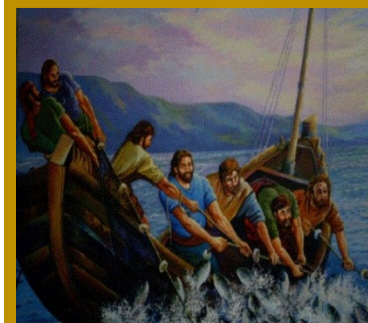
