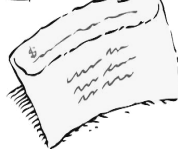

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

Stations of the Cross take place every Friday evening at 6:30pm in the church during Lent. Please make an effort to attend. This devotion gives us an opportunity to reflect on the Passion of Christ.



The Stations of the Cross are a 14-step Catholic devotion that commemorates Jesus Christ's last day on Earth as a man. The 14 devotions, or stations, focus on specific events of His last day,

beginning with His condemnation. The stations are commonly used as a mini pilgrimage as the individual moves from station to station. At each station, the individual recalls and meditates on a specific event from Christ's last day. Specific prayers are recited, then the individual moves to the next station until all 14 are complete.
