Dear ***Caring for Our Present, Planning for Our Future*** Capital Campaign Participant,

As the calendar year end approaches, we would like to offer a couple of reminders regarding Internal Revenue Service regulations surrounding your gifts to the ***Caring for Our Present, Planning for Our Future*** Capital Campaign during the month of December.

Consistent with Internal Revenue Service regulations, all year end gifts must be postmarked with a 2014 date to be recorded as a gift in 2014. The postmark on the envelope will determine what year the gift is recorded in. Examples for clarification are listed below:

- If TCF receives a gift with a check dated 12/31/2014 on 1/3/2015, but the postmark on the envelope reads 12/31/2014 (or earlier) then TCF will post the date of the gift as 12/31/2014.
- If TCF receives a gift with a check dated 12/31/2014, but the postmark of the envelope reads 1/1/2015 (or later) then it will be posted as a gift received in 2015.


TCF will also record all hand delivered gifts received at the foundation on December 31, 2014 by noon as a 2014 gift. We are located at 5310 Harvest Hill Road Suite 248 Dallas, TX 75230 and can be reached at 972-661-9792.

As for contributions charged on a donor's bank credit card, they are only deductible in the year the charge is made. If a donor wants to make a gift or pay a pledge payment by credit card for 2014 they must have their written request to TCF by noon on December 31, 2014.

ALL PAYMENTS, PLEDGE CARDS, ETC. GIVEN TO PARISH VOLUNTEERS OR CHANGING OUR WORLD PERSONNEL MUST BE DELIVERED TO THE CATHOLIC FOUNDATION ON DECEMBER 31, 2014 BY NOON IN ORDER TO BE COUNTED AS A 2014 GIFT.
