LNMV Religious Ed.:

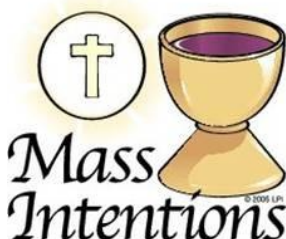
Classes resume this week on Wednesday, January 2. Not signed up yet on FORMED? Just login onto <https://lnmv.formed.org>.
