Holy Cross Happenings:

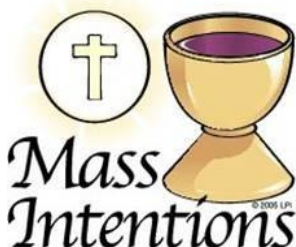
