Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, Summer is in full swing, and as we are about to enter the 2019 – 2020 academic year at Holy Family School, I would like to update you on milestones we hit last year, and inform you on exciting new improvements for our school in the upcoming year.

Over the 2018 – 2019 school year, we purchased new textbooks and dry erase boards for our classrooms, as well as upgraded and renovated the bathrooms in the school. Over the summer, the school has been patching the ceiling tiles, painting the rooms of the school, and redesigning our school library. Before the school year begins, we will be replacing the school doors on the outside of the building, and in our Allen Drury Room.

On the grounds of Holy Family, the playground will have fill added and the trees will be trimmed and cleaned up for the safety of the school children.

For the new school year, the Archdiocese of Washington has chosen Holy Family to begin a STEM program in our school. The objective of the program is to graduate students with the skills, knowledge, and thinking strategies that prepare them to be innovative, creative, and systematic problem-solvers in STEM fields of study and work.

Another addition in the curriculum will be the community garden that is behind our church. The students will be assisting, studying and experimenting with growing the plants in the science program. This food in-turn will be donated to our food pantry.

We have begun the process of updating the technology with the support of an IT company located in Washington D.C. We are taking steps to ensure our technology is current and to expand our curriculum. Some examples include new Google Chromebooks for students in classrooms, replacing projectors, adding smartboards, improving the WiFi, and installing a server that will create more efficiency and safety for our students online.

The Archdiocese is also assisting Holy Family School in creating and implementing a new marketing plan. The first step being to launch the school's new website in mid-August. Seeing this as our primary mode of effective and quick communication with our local community, we

want to warrant everything is clear and unified. All these improvements are in thanks to Father Matt, and to the teachers and staff of Holy Family.

Lastly, I would like to thank the parishioners who help serve the lunches to students as well as volunteer at the school. Parish involvement is always welcome and very helpful in our community in evangelization.

We ask for your prayers for our students and staff for the new school year, and are looking forward to our future here at Holy Family!
