Liturgical Notes of Interest

Epiphany and Liturgical Dates: Traditionally in the Church a proclamation of dates would take place after the Gospel today. This proclamation of the date of Easter and the other moveable feasts of the liturgical year dates from a time when calendars were not readily available. It was necessary to make known the date of Easter in advance, since many celebrations of the liturgical year depend on its date. For example, the number of Sundays that follow Epiphany, the date of Ash Wednesday, and the number of Sundays that follow Pentecost are all computed in relation to Easter. Do you know how the date for Easter itself is computed? It is the first Sunday after the first full moon after the Spring Equinox.

Thrones? Dominions? Powers? In the Preface (prayers just before the Holy Holy) we often hear these terms. For example:

'...the Angels praise your majesty, Dominions adore and Powers tremble before you. Heaven and the Virtues of heaven and the blessed Seraphim worship together with exultation.'

What is all that about? These are the titles of the various spiritual hosts of heaven, collectively often referred to as 'angels'. There are 9 'choirs' or orders of angelic beings, namely: Angels, Archangels, Principalities, Powers, Virtues, Dominions, Thrones, Seraphim and Cherubim.
