**STRESSED? TAKE A BREATH:** Did you know practicing simple breathing exercises helps you use your lungs better by getting in touch with your natural breathing rhythm? Conscious breathing also helps lower your blood pressure, controls harmful stress hormones and improves your mood. Try one of these techniques to center your mind and release everyday tension. **1)** Sit in a comfortable position. Take a deep breath in through your nose and hold for several seconds. Breathe out through your mouth as you relax with each breath. Repeat three to 10 times. **2)** From a standing position, bend forward from the waist with your knees slightly bent and let your arms dangle close to the floor. As you take a deep breath in, return to a standing position by rolling up slowly, lifting your head last. ## The Pastor's Corner:

**Today's readings** speak of our God who chooses not only involvement, but even dependence upon people and their capacity to communicate with a caring creator and redeemer. St. Paul addresses the Corinthians' question about spiritual gifts. In addition to ministries and works, there are "gifts," charisma manifesting the Spirit in extraordinary ways. Exceptional faith, healing, tongues, and prophecy are but a few of these gifts. Paul identifies the Lord as sole source of these gifts and teaches they must be shared for the common good. As your pastor, I always appreciate your many gifts and your willingness to share your talents with our parishes.

**The wedding feast of Cana** is a manifestation of God's glory. In Jesus first miracle, He stresses the place of his mother, Mary, in the work of redemption. It is, in fact, Mary who triggers Jesus' first act of public ministry by saying to Him: "They have no wine." It was a simple request showing that she trusted that her son would immediately respond and help. Jesus' response to her seemed slightly brusque. He said, "Woman, what is that to me and you; my hour has not yet come." The only other place where Jesus calls his mother "woman" is at His passion as she stood beneath the cross. Then He handed her over to the care of John and made her the mother of all of us. Our original mother was the "woman" Eve. But Eve as woman, handed down to us original sin and death. In calling His mother "Woman," Jesus seems to be saying, "You are the new Woman, you replace Eve, you shall suffer with me in redeeming all peoples; you will be called blessed by all generations." The unerring trustful access Mary had to Jesus here - all she had to do was point out the couple's need - assures us that all we have to do is go to Mary and she will plead our case with Jesus. And, as surely as Jesus responded to Mary by turning the jars of water into some 150 gallons of wine, Jesus will also attend to our need brought to Him by Mary.
