## Terms of Reference

### Background:

St John Paul II Parish is an amalgamation of three churches, each with their own Liturgy Committees or equivalent. With the amalgamation has come the opportunity to coordinate efforts across the three worship sites.

### Current Situation:

Each of the three Churches functions with its own group of dedicated volunteers who have displayed great interest in looking after Mass-related services including: Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Altar Servers, Sacristans, Lectors, Music, and Ushers across the Parish.

### Liturgy Committee Chair Required:

Our Parish of John Paul II is seeking a volunteer "Chair" to coordinate the activities of those currently looking after the Mass-related services. Reporting to Father, the Liturgy Chair will play a key role in coordinating the Liturgy activities across the three Churches. From time-to-time, the Chair will be asked to brief the Parish Pastoral Council. The Chair will be responsible to coordinate training events for each of the services (e.g. Altar Servers). This does not mean that the Chair needs to be the subject matter expert in each of these services! From time-to-time, the Chair will be asked to brief the Parish Pastoral Council. The Chair will serve for a term of three years with an option of a second term.
