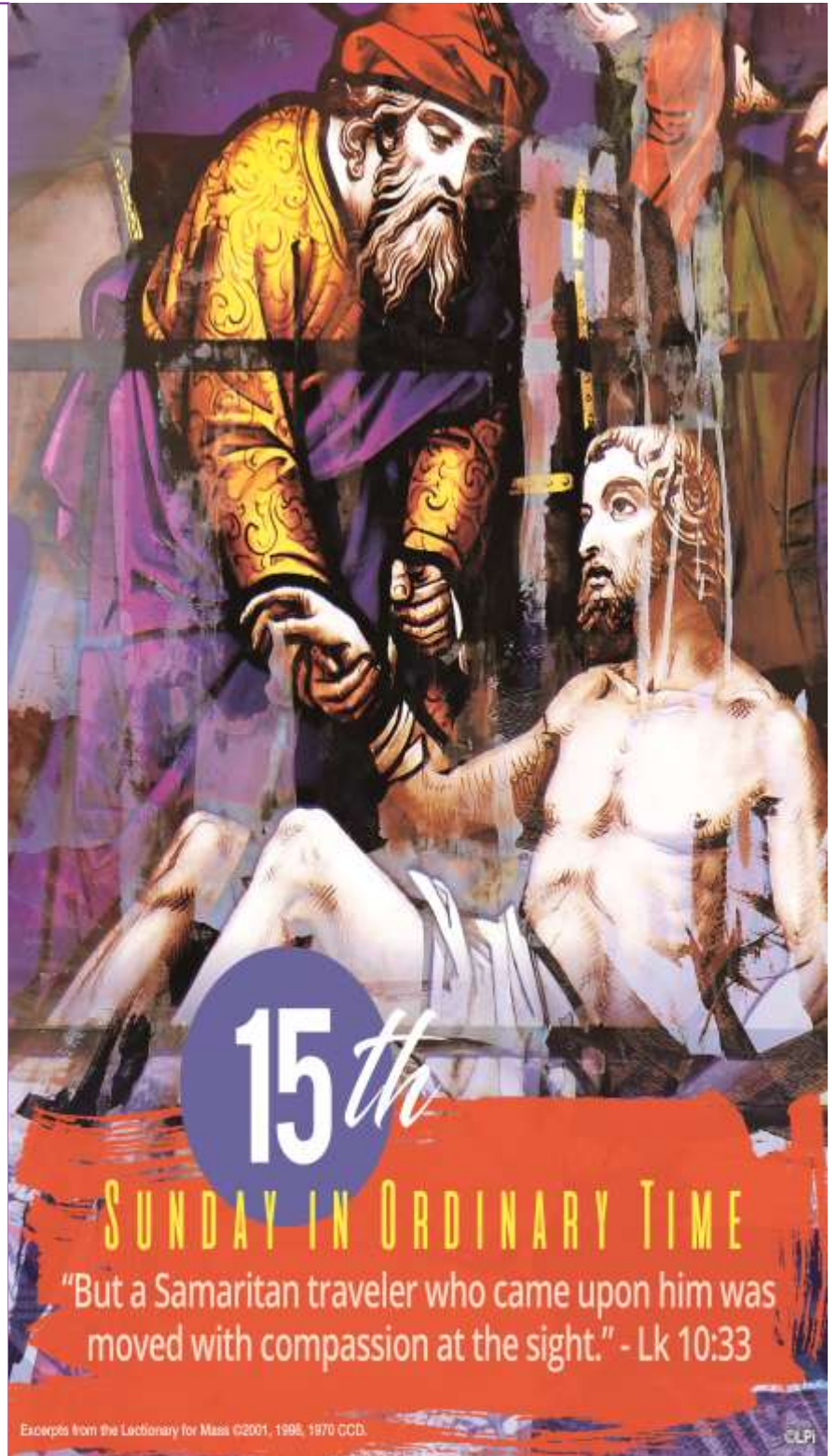

Recently, Holy Spirit Parish received this letter from some visitors to one of our weekend Masses. We thought this would be appropriate for this weekend's Gospel!

To Father Fred Morse and the blessed parishioners —

On June 8, my daughter, wife, and I attended 4 PM mass. During the Mass, my wife became ill. She informed me that she was feeling faint, so I took her through the doors to the back of the church., when she proceeded to collapse into my arms and onto the floor. Before I could even ask for help, I had a half a dozen parishioners offering their assistance. They all assisted my wife in various ways, leading to her quick recovery. Now my wife was feeling much more herself. A suggestion was made to take her to Urgent Care to make sure *there wasn't any other health issue going on.* Before I could even say anything, another caring parishioner offered to show us the way to Urgent Care. My wife, our daughter, and I got into our car and followed the person to Urgent Care. When we got there, the person went inside and got a wheelchair for my wife. Now I can tell you that it was a hydration concern along with some over-the-counter medication she was taking for a sinus cold that caused this health issue. After testing, she was feeling *herself and was released... I haven't mentioned anyone by name; reason being, I didn't have all the names of the people who assisted my wife and me. I feel it would be an injustice if I couldn't mention them all.* What I need to tell you is that, in all my life, I have never seen an outpouring of caring as I did that afternoon. On behalf of my wife, daughter, and myself, I want the biggest heart-felt thank-you to go to all those involved. God continues His outstanding work. Our heart-felt thanks and love...

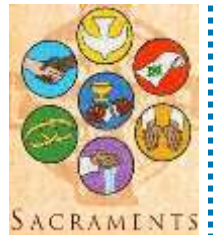

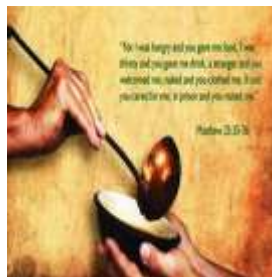

Priests from the area will be assisting during the day, which will include Mass, some talks, a holy hour, and the opportunity to receive the sacrament of reconciliation.

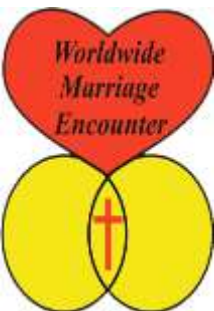
