The Sacred Steps is for those Catholics who are divorced and gathers twice a month with a focus on healing and growth through education, prayer, scripture, catechesis and various learning exercises that are combined to accompany you as you heal and grow. The program features a General Session which focuses on prayer, scripture, and education on how to heal from your divorce. The second part of this series is the Support Group where you implement your own story through the exercises presented at each chapter. The program is led by trained clergy and pastoral ministry staff.

The Sacred Steps to Peace Catholic Divorce Recovery will begin in WAM/Summit counties on October 11, 2019 at Sacred Heart Parish in Wadsworth, OH at 7:00 p.m. General Session meetings will be the 2nd Friday of the month; full calendar will be given out at first session.
