- Complete a project on a saint of your choice. This may be the name you choose for your Confirmation name, which is the name used to present you to the Bishop. This can be your baptismal name, or the name of a saint you admire or whose life inspires you.
- Invite someone to be my sponsor, after completing the Sponsor Discernment Paper.
- Submit the Sponsor Verification Form once my sponsor has accepted my invitation, fully understanding what they are undertaking.
