A poem about St. Mary Parish through the years, written by our parishioner, Ms. Patty Butkovich, will be for sale after all masses this weekend.

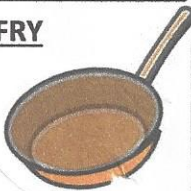

Jesus Revealed – Lesson 18 – The Alpha and the
Omega.
