When the apostles gathered together with Jesus on the mount called Olivet, they asked him about restoring the kingdom of Israel, which prompted this response from our Lord: "It is not for you to know the times or the seasons that the Father has established by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." St. Luke informs us that "When he said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight." (see Acts 1:6-9). At the end of Mark's gospel we are given additional information as to precisely where Jesus went: "So then the Lord Jesus, after he spoke to them, was taken up into heaven and took his seat at the right hand of God" (16:19). As we stand looking into the eternal depths of the sky, not seeing our Lord, yet knowing by faith where he is and that he resides in our hearts, we have no need to worry over those circumstances of life which drive thorns of pain deep within us, for all things are passing. Christ has risen. Indeed our lord has risen! --Taken from Catholic Online
