### The Liturgical Year

In the Roman Catholic Liturgical Calendar, there is a designated schedule of readings for each Sunday Mass. The readings in their designated schedule are included in a book that is called the "Lectionary."

The weekend readings are on a three year cycle, A, B and C. In Year A, we read primarily from the Gospel of Matthew. In Year B, we hear the gospels from Mark and in Year C, we listen to the Gospel of Luke. If you are wondering about the Gospel of John, we listen to it every year during the seasons of Lent and Easter.

The information above is actually for the New Missal or the Novus Ordo. In addition to years A, B and C, there is also a daily Mass cycle A and B. Theoretically, if a person faithfully attends Mass for at least 3 years in a row, he or she would hear most of the Scripture – especially most of the Gospels – in that 3 year cycle.
