We have had a HEARING LOOP SYSTEM installed in our church. A HEARING LOOP SYSTEM is to hearing aids what WIFI is to a computer. Hearing sound that is broadcast through a HEARING LOOP SYSTEM increases the functionality of the Telecoil (T-COIL) equipped hearing aids by 100%. It does not replace a sound system. It works in conjunction with the broadcast sound delivering clear, clean and customized sound right into the ears. The sound that is heard is without echo or distortion, so it greatly increases the clarity of the speech and allows people to easily understand what is being said. Most hearing aids are compatible with the new system. It may require a quick visit to your Hearing Healthcare Professional to have your tele-coil turned on for use with the Hearing Loop System. I'm back! From May 27 to June 5 I was on retreat and pilgrimage in Rome and Assisi with 24 other priests of our diocese and Bishop Perez. The best parts for me were celebrating mass in the chapel where St. Francis received the stigmata and praying and reflecting on the life of Sts. Clare and Francis near St. Clare's tomb. I prayed a lot for our two communities, especially near the tombs of Sts. Peter and Paul. More on this trip during homilies and pastor articles. **Bishop Perez celebrated mass at St. Bernard on May 24.** Our turnover in the office led to this not being well-announced in the bulletin, which I apologize for. I did place it in the mass announcements a few weeks beforehand because he specifically asked that everyone be invited, not just the Hispanic Community. **St. Bernard Town Hall Meeting 1** will be on Tuesday, July 16th from 7:00-8:15 p.m. in the main church. We will share preliminary results of the building studies and begin to surface ideas, input and names of people interested in leading what efforts may come in the building renovation. Realizing summer plans may be in the way of this conversation, **Town Hall Meeting 2** will be sometime in September and will follow the same format. Both meetings will begin with a brief prayer service. **The United States Bishops** met this past week and one fruit of their meeting is a transparent plan of what they are doing and all of us should do to **combat clerical abuse**.
