PASTOR'S NOTE

REFLECTIONS FROM ROME AND ASSISI

Before too much more of the summer goes on, I want to share with you four things from retreat this year.

In Rome there is a "talking statue" named Pasquino. Pasquino is a battered Hellenistic-style statue dating to the third century BC, which was unearthed in the fifteenth century and is still located in a piazza on the southwest corner of the Palazzo Braschi (Museo di Roma). The custom is that you write a complaint you have about the city and post it near the statue and somehow "mysteriously" it will write you a reply within a few days. It's reassuring to know that as ancient and beautiful as Rome is, it has had its critics and imperfections through all its time, especially by its residents. All the elements of humanity are always present, even if they go unnoticed or unrecognized.

We celebrated mass in the chapel where St. Francis received the stigmata near Florence in La Verna. I was in awe to just sit there and ponder how, after all his best work was done, Francis then received the stigmata possibly as a sign of affirmation. Knowing that in Canton, Ohio last century Rhoda Wise received the stigmata, it got me thinking: Why can't Akron also be Assisi?

St. Clare of Assisi was a great disciple, companion, co-founder and balance to St. Francis. Her order and teachings continue to profoundly impact the world as his do. In her basilica I prayed for balance and right relationship with all the people in my life, especially the women. I took her on as a special patron for this. One day, just with a cell phone camera, one of our priests' photos turned out a pair of illumined hands hovering over his head in the photo as he sat innocently outside her basilica. This makes me aware that while the movements of betrayal like Judas at the last supper are at work in the Church, so are the movements of grace, guidance and strength from God Like the Eucharist at the last supper. How may I follow the movements of grace within the Church?

We are the Church! We have legitimate complaints and sins! We are invited to participate in movements of grace! Akron and Summit County can be Assisi, but it will take more than construction equipment to make it so! It will take our cooperation with God's movements of grace.
